For the sailing portion of this camp, a **MCSC Swim Check Form** needs to be completed. It must be signed by a certified lifeguard and on file by the first day of camp. This form can be found on the next page. Campers will be unable to partake in the sailing portion of this camp if this form is not completed and returned before or by the camp start date.

In addition, in order to have the best sailing experience possible, please be aware of the following information:

1. Be prepared to go sailing every day.
2. Bring the following sailing gear to class every day:
 - Non-skid shoes only (sailing shoes or boots, tennis shoes, etc.)
 - Open-toed shoes are not allowed! No sandals, Tevas, etc!
 - A complete change of clothes and a towel, including an extra pair of socks and shoes.
 - A sailing hat or baseball cap, sunglasses, sailing gloves (optional).
 - Sunscreen and a bottle of water.
 - A mask. (Students will wear masks while on land or the docks, but will not sail with them on.)
3. Be prepared to HAVE FUN! ☺
