Our ability to remain committed to serving our audiences would not be possible without you. I thank you for your support during these challenging times and hope you will continue this journey with us as we strive for a better future.







2021 Year in Review

January – March

Discovery World offered the School and Community Initiative (SCI) Program to school and community groups throughout Wisconsin and Illinois (ran into June). Students received virtual instruction, tours of the aquarium, and hands-on experiment kits to accompany their live, real-time instruction sessions with a Discovery World educator. In March, the museum also reopened to the public with safety protocols in place and timed ticketing.

April – June

Discovery World hosted talented, local artisans on our promenade with the Milwaukee Makers Market. The building was also buzzing with young summer campers starting the second week of June for what was to be a fun-filled three months of science-focused camps.

July - September

We hosted our Wheels & Water event, which featured local heroes and safety vehicles from the City, and a Mermaid Echo, a live mermaid experience in the Reiman Aquarium. We also invited our wonderful members for a fireworks event in September in conjunction with Summerfest and again hosted artisans for the Milwaukee Maker's Market. More than 700 campers joined us throughout the summer.

October - December

Discovery World welcomed back two of our most popular events -Sci-Fi Family Day and Halloween Members Night. Sci-Fi Family Day featured characters from the world of fantasy and Halloween Member's Night gives our loyal members a chance to trick-or-treat in costume throughout the museum. The Kohl's Design It! Lab also reopened its doors in November after closing during the pandemic, and we hosted an event called Space Out! featuring all things outer space. The second floor of the technology building was steaming ahead with the opening of our new train exhibit, All Aboard!, and we hosted another Milwaukee Makers Market. To wrap up the year, Santa greeted children over several weekends during the month of December.









Membership in Review

We had **23,248** individual adults and children make up our **5,563** family memberships at the close of 2021. We also offered our Corporate Partner Employee Membership Discount Program in which employees of our corporations and foundation supporters receive a percentage discount off summer camp, membership purchases, and more. We had **74 organizations** serve as corporate partners in 2021.

Community Partners

Milwaukee County Disability Services Division (MCDSD)

We continued a strong partnership with the MCDSD, which provides a variety of services for families of children with disabilities, including opportunities for enriching experiences throughout the community, like a Discovery World membership.

Essential Workers Membership Matching Program

For every new membership, gift membership, or membership renewal purchased while the museum remained closed to the public, Discovery World donated a free membership to the employers of essential workers.

We donated memberships to Roundy's, Pick 'n Save and Metro Market, Ignite the Spirit Fund, Milwaukee Firefighters, and Children's Wisconsin.





Learning in our Labs

The Kohl's Design-It! Lab is one of the most popular Discovery World destinations, as it allows museum visitors an opportunity to create their own vision and design projects alongside our talented lab educators. Our staff provided **21,546 experiences** to guests visiting Discovery World.

We provided MPS' Extended Learning Program **600 activity kits** for their students throughout the summer as an extension of our **SCI Program**.

Each classroom space provides opportunities for school group and camp learning throughout the year.

Reiman Aquarium

The Reiman Aquarium, housed in our "Aquatarium Building" is the most popular experience on the Discovery World campus. The aquarium allows visitors to explore the strange, beautiful, and fascinating creatures from around the world, including the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans, the rivers of the Amazon Basin, African Rift Lakes, and right here in the Great Lakes. Guests can also pet stingrays and sturgeon. Families bond over meeting adorable turtles, ball python, poison dart frogs, and so many more animals within the live collection. The museum also employs several full-time aquarists who bring tremendous talent and expertise to the animals. Further, the Reiman Aquarium is a great location for volunteerism, as it welcomes scuba divers, subject matter experts, and friendly faces wanting to lend their time.

The Reiman Aquarium has welcomed over **2.2 million visitors** since it opened in 2010. In 2021, we housed **147 species** and over **350 individual animals**, including fish, reptiles, amphibians, inverts, and corals.

In the spring of 2021, the Reiman Aquarium staff worked together with the Education Team to record Q&As for the SCI "Virtual Aquarium Tour". These streams provided students an opportunity to ask aquarists questions about their virtual tour and the ins and outs of managing an aquarium.

The Aquarium staff welcomed 6 interns, 3 new aquarists, and a new Aquarium Curator. Our 23 volunteers were an amazing asset to daily operations both behind the scenes and diving in the tanks.

Discovery World received a donation for the aquarists to expand their knowledge by taking the E-quarist Vet Course, an online class designed by a veterinarian specifically for zoos and aquariums. This course strengthens the skills of the aquarists to provide even better care of our aquatic friends.



School & Community Initiative (SCI)



In the 2020/21 school year, the vast array of field trips that we offer to schools – both on scholarship and not – could not happen. Many schools held classes virtually, and those with in-person instruction were not taking in-person field trips. In response, Discovery World created virtual tours, activity kits, video-based labs, and equipment loans to provide a broad range of instructional supports for educators to enhance their students' educational experience. High-quality science education should not go by the wayside simply because schools were not taking field trips. So we brought Discovery World field trips and labs to the schools.

We provided hands-on STEM activities and instruction to 12,124 students from 95 schools. With the return of in-person field trips in the fall of 2021, we welcomed 727 students back into our education spaces for experiences on robotics, water quality, taste, circuitry, physics, magnets, and more.

In December of 2021, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Metro Milwaukee once again began working with our Education Team to offer in-person science activities.

Our educational programming consistently receives wonderful feedback. Here's what a few teachers had to say:

Summer Camp

Over 11 weeks, **785** students (grades 1-8) took part in our summer camp program. Each week-long camp here at Discovery World covered a different topic, including design, automation, robotics, food science, fishing, and more! We capped capacity due to Covid-19 restrictions, to keep our campers safe.


